IMPORTANT NOTES:

- There will be over 13 weeks of holidays in the 2025/26 academic year. Parents are urged to schedule holidays during these times and avoid any absences that disrupt Madrasah attendance.
- The full academic calendar has been provided in advance to assist with planning. Absences outside these dates will typically be marked as unauthorised.
- **Our Attendance Policy:** Two unauthorised absences in a week or three in a month may lead to removal from the Madrasah.
- If due to exceptional circumstances, planned leave for 2 days or more is required during term time then a "Leave Request Form" must be obtained, completed, and approved before making any bookings. No planned leave should be booked prior to receiving a formal decision from the Madrasah.

MANDATORY DATES:

- ALL Mothers to attend the End of Year Girls Jalsah (irrespective of which side your child is taught on)
- ALL Fathers to attend the End of Year Boys Jalsah (irrespective of which side your child is taught on)
- Mothers to attend Parents Evening of those children who are taught by Apas (females)
- Fathers to attend Parents Evening of those children who are taught by Ustadhs (males)
